




The Casey Nearing Collection

- 87. General Tom Thumb and Wife CDV; has some scratches; backside is printed "Compliments of Charles S Stratton/ Lavinia Warren Stratton"; published by E & HT Anthony & Co, NY; see #88 for more info; 4" x 2-1/2"; \$40.00
- 88. CDV of General Tom Thumb (actual name Charles Stratton), Wife (Lavinia Warren) and Child; has foxing and slight picture loss; he only reached 3.25 feet tall; Tom Thumb was one of the world's most famous performers in the 1840s-70s; he worked and partnered with P.T. Barnum; one of the greatest hoaxes of the time was the Thumb baby; Lavinia claims it was all a hoax but some historians claim it wasn't; there is still a tombstone today for their baby; 4" x 2-3/8"; \$45.00
- 89. Union 1862 Pass to travel from Memphis, TN to Cairo, IL; from the office of the provost marshal; good for passage on a steam boat not in government use; has folds and rough edges; 5-1/2" x 3-1/2"; \$250.00
- 90. 1860 Union Republic Election Ballot for Ohio; republicans won; Brinkerhoff, Sargeant and Murray; only 5 available; 5-1/2" x 2-1/2"; \$20.00 each

He was Chief of Staff of the United States Army during the 1930s and played a prominent role in the Pacific theater during World War II. He received the Medal of Honor for his service in the Philippines Campaign, which made him and his father Arthur MacArthur Jr. the first father and son to be awarded the medal. He was one of only five to rise to the rank of General of the Army in the US Army, and the only one conferred the rank of field marshal in the Philippine Army; overall is 8" x 6"; some soiling; \$275.00
- 95. Indian Wars US Cavalry Iron Picket Pin; good condition; slight wear; used to tie down horses so they don't wander; 1870s; 14" x 7/8"; \$135.00
- 96. Rare Item; J. W. Jordan Postal Cover; "Catch that Boomer in Ten Days or return to J.W. Jordan, Pawnee Agency, Ind(ian) Ter'y"; during the Civil War, Jordan mustered into F Company Indian Territory 1st Cherokee Cavalry; he was wounded in 1863 at Honey Springs, Indian Territory; after the war, he was a special agent for the Cherokee Nation, member of the Indian Police, a United States military scout and a United States deputy marshal; he was a founding father of Triangle county; comes with a packet of info about Jordan; cover is 8-3/4" x 3-3/4"; shows aging but is pretty good; awesome history!; \$195.00
- 97. 1909 Insular Government of the Philippine Islands Military Salary Check; good for six dollars; Manila, PI; signed multiple times on the back; has folds and stains; 8-1/4" x 3-3/8"; \$60.00
