

- 135. 1945 Japanese Invasion Money 100 Yen for Use in Hong Kong; this was the highest denomination military currency issued by Japan; civilians had to accept it even though it had no backing; this note was printed in Hong Kong and is just like the 100 yen Japanese note except it had "Military Currency" overprint; only 10 available; \$8.00 each
- 136. 1944 WWII German Nazi 1 Reichsmark Military Currency Note; this Wehrmacht military scrip note was used by Nazi Germany to pay its troops during the final months of WWII; dated September 15, 1944; soldiers were paid in military scrip while in transit and once he arrived at his post, the notes could be converted to local notes or occupation notes; the front of the note includes the eagle holding the swastika and the inscription "Deuteche Wehrmacht"; the back of the note includes regulations and instructions for use; only 5 available; \$16.99 each
- 137. 1942 WWII German Nazi Hitler Youth 5 Reichsmark; these were made to replace the 5 Reichsmark silver coins; the front features a young German man and a small eagle and swastika; the back features the Brunswick Cathedral and Lion Statue; well worn; only 15 available; \$12.00 each
- 138. WWII Philippine Guerilla Notes; various guerilla bands produced this rough currency to finance their activites fighting the Japanese during WWII; guerillas would set up currency boards which would issue the notes; generally each province would have its own currency board; the names of three members of the currency board would appear on each note, which was a very brave and brazen act of defiance against the Japanese invaders; only 25 available; \$4.99 each or special: 3 notes for \$10
- 139. WWII Japanese Invasion Currency \$10 Note for Malaya; Japan conquered Malaya in 1942; these notes are famous because Malaya's money was in dollars just like the United States. Many Americans saw these notes as proof that Japan planned to conquer the United States (and those stories still exist today); only 30 available; \$2.00 each
- 140. Southern Comfort Advertisement; front of the ad looks like a Confederate \$5 note; the backside is the Southern Comfort info; \$2.00 each
